

PROCEEDINGS OF THE FOSTER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

March 24th, 2026

At 9:00 am, Chairman Copenhaver called the Foster County Commission Special Meeting to order. Roll call included Commissioner Pat Copenhaver, Commissioner David Utke, Commissioner Becky Hagel and Commissioner Alan Scanson via phone. Also present was Chief Deputy Auditor/Treasurer Hailey K Bachmeier.

The first item on the special meeting agenda was the 2002 International truck. Commissioner Scanson informed the Board of County Commissioners that Road Superintendent Nate Monson recommended selling the truck due to ongoing mechanical issues and frequent breakdowns. Commissioner Hagel motioned to allow Road Superintendent Nate Monson to sell the 2002 International Truck, seconded by Commissioner Utke. All voted aye and the motion passed.

Chief Deputy Auditor/Treasurer Hailey K Bachmeier presented a Flexible Transportation Program Funding Reimbursement Request #10 that will be sent to North Dakota Department of Transportation for invoice 190299011 pertaining to the gravel regrading project by Grace City, project number FXS-1602(067). Bachmeier asked for approval of authorized signatures. Commissioner Utke motioned to approve the authorized signatures for the Flexible Transportation Program Funding Reimbursement Request #10, seconded by Commissioner Hagel. All voted aye and the motion passed.
