

PROCEEDINGS OF THE FOSTER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

March 30th, 2026

At 8:30 am, Chairman Copenhaver called the Foster County Commission Special Meeting to order. Roll call included Commissioner Pat Copenhaver, Commissioner David Utke, Commissioner Becky Hagel and Commissioner Alan Scanson. Also present was Supervisor of the Carrington Ambulance Allyssa Lewis, and Chief Deputy Auditor/Treasurer Hailey K Bachmeier. Commissioner Paul Roller arrived at the special meeting at 8:35 am.

The ambulance building overhead door was discussed at the special meeting. Commissioner Utke reported that Allyssa Lewis, Supervisor of the Carrington Ambulance Service had contacted him on Friday regarding issues with the building's overhead door. Lewis explained that the door has been malfunctioning, frequently becoming stuck during both opening and closing. She also noted that during a recent 911 call, the door did not open in time, resulting in it being struck. Commissioner Utke stated that the Board of County Commissioners typically prefers to review quotes from multiple vendors; however, due to the urgency of the situation, timely action is necessary. Lewis informed the Board that she had obtained a quote from ES Doors in the amount of \$3,765.37. Commissioner Hagel added that Kelly Hagel of Hagel Construction inspected the door on Sunday, March 29, 2026, and estimated that repairs would cost no more than \$3,000.00, pending a final bid after consulting with Central City Lumber Outside Sales employee, John Rzaszutak. Following discussion, the BOCC agreed to table the decision until the next regular commissioner meeting on April 7, 2026, to allow time for additional quotes to be reviewed.

With no further business, Chairman Copenhaver adjourned the meeting at 8:53 am.
