REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

The regular scheduled meeting of the Foster County Water Resource Board was held on Wednesday, June 12, 2024, commencing at 7:00 am at the Foster County Courthouse in the Jury Room with all board members present. Also present were Danielle Koepplin, Secretary/Treasurer, Mike Gussiaas, Trevor VandeHoven, and Karl Hoppe. Attorney Kale Van Bruggen and Engineer Jennifer Malloy were present via Microsoft Teams.

Meeting was called to order by Chairman, Doug Zink.

AGENDA. The agenda was reviewed, and was followed for the balance of the meeting.
